



Military Family Assistance Programs

Family Tree has contracted with the Human Services Departments of Adams County, Arapahoe County and Jefferson County to provide assistance to eligible military families residing in their respective county. Family Tree is a not-for-profit agency that has been serving families in the Metro Denver area since 1976.

The Military Family Assistance Program serves military families with children where one parent is either an active duty service member or a recent veteran. Ex-spouses and widows with children are also eligible for services. This program provides three months of case management during which time a case manager works closely with the family to address unmet needs and promote stability. The Military Family Assistance Program provides services and referrals to connect eligible families to both community and military resources, such as counseling, employment, and education services. Additionally, need-based financial assistance is available for items such as school clothing and supplies, utilities, rental assistance and extracurricular activities for children.
