Arvada

Brookview Apartments

- Wash exterior of windows accessible from ground
- Wash entry door and storm doors on all units
- Cut fence height at parking area to back of building 6' down to 4' (expertise required)
- Repair downspouts around the building
- Lay new ground cover (bark and pea gravel)
- Xeroscape backyard 60' x 20' section

Marshall Street North (transitional housing units)

- Trim trees
- Wash walls and clean from move out September, 2010
- Adopt a bungalow: Direct support for Family Tree Clients
 - Maintain grounds, exterior of house and minor repairs
 - Provide modern updates and renovations

Englewood

House of Hope

- Wash outside and inside windows that can be reached safely
- Install drapes in client rooms
- Take down old wiring and phone lines (must possess electrical expertise)
- Organize linen closet
- Organize and clean food storage area
- Organize donations (including the prize closets and/or clothes closet)
- Yard work
- Install liners on shelves
- Repair wooden play set for safety of children
- Brush stain sealer on play set

Lakewood

Gemini Building

- Construct new storage shed
- Wash interior walls
- Deep clean restrooms, shower rooms, empty bedrooms, common areas
- Cut and install plywood walls in 11 bedrooms (requires expertise and a minimum four day commitment)
- Paint basement bathroom and install cubbies to store hygiene products \$
- Paint 20 bedrooms
- Replace 20' worth of base boards in day room on main floor
- Paint conference room and stairwell
- Build cabinet/entertainment center for upstairs day room
- Lightly remodel and paint Clinical and Therapist offices
- Install acoustic dampening panels in dining room to decrease the echoing effect

- Grounds cleanup
- Trim the bushes on property

1. Purchase 4-6 large whiskey barrels and fill them with top soil and perennials to make store more appealing to customers
2. Remove paint from store front windows
3. Clean out garage and organize according to season
4. Install new window treatments \$
5. Install new exterior lighting \$
6. Install new crank awning and fence for donation area \$

Administration Building

1. Broom curbs and pull weeds around parking lot in rock area
2. Install a pair of plywood doors on the storage shed at the back of the parking lot
3. Design and install art (sculpture/display) and/or xeroscape for front, East entrance
4. Repair existing benches in outside staff break area
5. Install round table for outside staff break area

Confidential Location

Women in Crisis shelter

- General clean up of outside play area
- Clean out the rain gutters
- Broom the parking lot and clean up the pine needles
- Wash windows inside and out
- Clean all interior and exterior windows
- Brush water stain sealer on play set
- Wall washing inside the facility
- Deep clean restrooms
- Organize donations to give to women and children in the shelter
- Spring cleaning: wash interior and exterior windows, clean baseboards, wash walls
- Plant perennials and/or bring hanging flower baskets
- Any other project, with approval, that you identify while visiting the property

Women In Crisis also accepts donations for the women and children who stay in the shelter. Often, they would not have the following supplies without your donation:

- Hygiene products: conditioner, brushes, picks/combs, toothbrushes, Clorox wipes
- Towels, washcloths
- Twin sheets, pillows, blankets
- Cleaning supplies,
- Bookshelf: 3-tiered shelf to hold client files
- Diapers: size 4, 5, or 6
- Socks, underwear and pj's for women and children (all sizes)
