

### A MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR & CEO

The beginning of what we now know to be the defining crisis of our lifetimes, was not the defining event of the past year for Family Tree. Our unifying approach to help people and families create lasting positive change maintained our impact despite the effects the pandemic had on the organization and our operations.

The year began with our sustained commitment to our culture of continuous improvement; to fundamentally change and enhance our practice of evaluation and align Family Tree's programs and operations across common informational domains. These efforts were informed by team members throughout the organization and validated through input by those we serve. Our year ended with moving from the planning and design stages of this work into the implementation phase.

The 2019-20 fiscal year also witnessed the opening of Family Tree GOALS (Generational Opportunities to Achieve Long-term Success) in August, a two-generational program in Aurora for families experiencing homelessness. In early 2020 facility renovations began to eventually support 19 households.

Like the rest of our community, our country and the world, the time from March of 2020 onward has arguably been the most difficult in Family Tree's history. Our team members took on this challenge in tremendous fashion, adapting and innovating to best serve our community given the innumerable constraints and barriers to success. Our community-based programs shifted quickly to virtual service platforms and the organization implemented critical life-saving protocols in all residential locations. At the same time, we felt the exceptional care and concern from people across our community, recognizing how vitally important Family Tree's programs and services are especially during this time. The outpouring of support, both financially and in the form of critical needs items, demonstrated this to our team and the people we serve.

Of course, the challenges persist as we look forward and continue to strive for the balance of keeping our team members and those we serve safe, while ensuring we are providing the necessary support to people in our community who need our help. Part of Family Tree's response to this challenge was to immediately implement hero/hazard pay for team members on the frontlines, and a swift commitment to keep our team intact and not make any reductions in force due to the adverse economic effects of the pandemic, or future uncertainties.

With so many unknowns for the coming year, our role will continue to include considerable preparations for many scenarios, to ensure Family Tree's vital role in the community is sustainable.

Maybe more than ever we can't do this necessary work without you - our stakeholders and supporters - and we are beyond grateful for all you do to support our mission to partner with all people to prevent and overcome the interconnected issues of child abuse, domestic violence, and homelessness to promote safety, healing and stability across generations.






Value of Volunteer Hours








