

COLORADO HOMELESSNESS CONTRIBUTION TAX CREDIT

The Homeless Contribution Tax Credit provides a 25% state income tax credit to Colorado taxpayers who contribute to eligible homelessness-related projects within Colorado.

HCTC replaces the Enterprise Zone Tax Credit.

Monetary gifts of \$200 or more to Family Tree qualify for the HCTC. Colorado Statute (C.R.S. 39-22-548) requires the taxpayer's full social security number and other personal identifying information to be included on the tax credit certificate.

A Colorado Tax ID is not an acceptable replacement for the social security number on the certificate. Family Tree is not able to store a donor's full social security number currently. We are accessing our ability to store information securely and safely.
